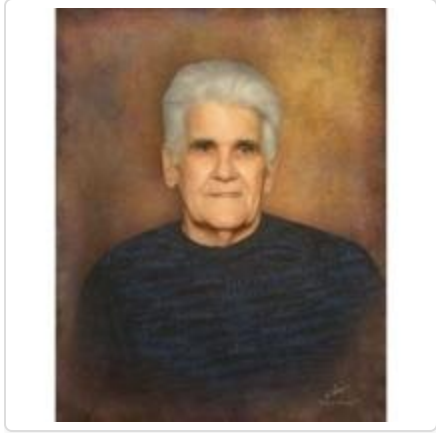




Carl R. Whorley

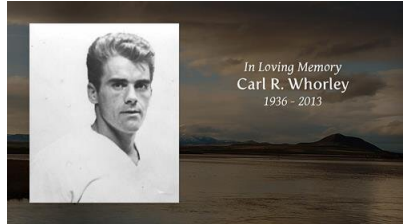
