Mr. Harry N. Richardson 87 passed away Friday, March 4 th , 2022, at his home surrounded by his loving family, under the care of Pruitt Hospice. Mr. Harry N. Richardson was born June 7th, 1934, on Anderson Street in Savannah, Georgia to the Late Benjamin Thaddeus Richardson & Evelyn Brown-Richardson. Harry grew up in Savannah, Georgia and attended the public schools of Chatham County. At an Early age he joined Litway Missionary Baptist Church and served as an usher until his health decline.
