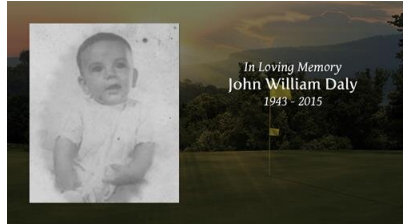
Funeral Services: 12 p.m. Friday in the Chapel of Bonaventure Funeral
