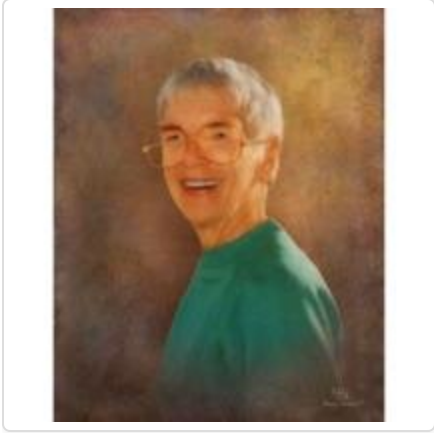




Madeline Adele Gidel
