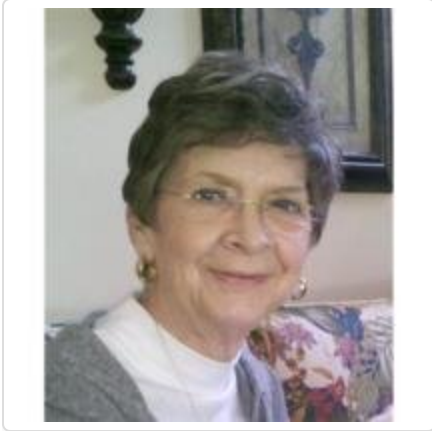




## Madelyn Lariscy Atkins
