Sandy Santillanez, age 86, of Davisboro, Georgia passed away Friday, May 22nd, 2015 at Washington County Regional Medical Center.

A native of Trinchera, Colorado, he was the son of Teofilo Santillanez and Petra Perea Santillanez. Sandy was retired after 26 years service in the U. S. Air Force. His service record included the Vietnam War and tours in Ecuador, Germany and England. A longtime resident of Savannah, moving here in the 1970's, Sandy later retired after 20 years with Tetley Tea. He had lived in Davisboro for the last 14 years. Involved with Adult Literacy in Savannah and teaching Sunday School, Sandy also volunteered at the Washington County Medical Center.
